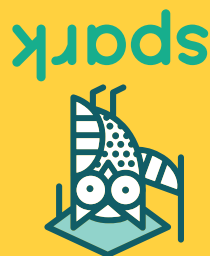
Food Pantries

Women's Giving Circle

MPSF Women's Giving Circle successfully launched in spring of 2022. Members donated prior to the gathering, and their resources were pooled to provide a grant to a Millard educator who had a solution to ensure the success of students or staff at MPS.

Members voted that evening to provide funding to the Millard North Middle School Unified Sports Program. This \$2,800 grant will allow the school to purchase new jerseys, sports equipment and bowling alley time, and host fun team building events throughout the year! This project was selected in part due to its sustainability and the number of students impacted by the program.

Remaining funds will go toward building a balance for a Women's Giving Circle Endowment Fund.
